- c. Jennica Murray and Mary Ellen Rosen were elected co-presidents of Community Council.
- d. Laurel Fetzer is the note taker. This was approved and seconded.
- e. Erik Fetzer- MHS PTSA president was approved to be an ex-officio member of Community council. This was approved by Anita Longhurst and seconded by Mary Ellen Rosen.
- f. Dr. Goldhardt gave the committee information on MHS AP testing data, ACT testing data and Sage testing data. We discussed the goals that the school has to improve these testing scores in the future.
 - i. Next year MHS is teaching a new SLCC concurrent enrollment course called Family....., also going to start an auto shop, psychology, and computer science class- all SLCC concurrent enrollment.
 - ii. AP art history will be taught next year at MHS by Jessica Garrett
 - iii. Every junior takes the ACT not just those who are going to apply to college. Our scores from 2014 reflect that change.
 - iv. Math teachers spent a lot of time prepping for the math core.
 - v. Added a new math teacher- Mrs. McGowan.
 - vi. Mr. Mayo is retiring at the end of the month. Danielle Whichard from Dicater Georgia has just been hired to take this job. Dr.

Goldhardt is impressed with her and excited for this new teacher to be at MHS.

- vii. Goal is literacy. SLO-student learning objectives are a new part of the teacher evaluations- 20% of their goals. These evaluations if not done, teacher loses \$4200. 00. They included class content, literacy objective and informational text. Amber Rydalch is the new teacher coach and is helping teachers write their SLO goals.
 - viii. We have a new teacher who is teaching the prostart classes- Chef Gray.
 - ix. New auto mechanics teacher Mr. Hassell from Price Utah. Cars are being used in the auto mechanics classes!!
9. A quick discussion was started about what grading is supposed to reflect. Dr. Goldhardt believes it should be mastery of the content. Not all classes are set up to represent this idea as their grading rubric. There is a goal to get consistency in the grading area.
