

Community Council Agenda 1-8-15

- Approve Minutes from November
- Another opportunity for school community council training will be held on Thursday, January 15th from 3:30 – 8:00 pm at Woods Cross High School.
- Progress toward working around firewall?—example use of Kahn academy.com, videos, or tutorials on YouTube
- Follow up on proposal to upgrade computers and increase RAM. Estimated cost \$5-6,000, but John Nelson of the district is willing to pay half of the cost.
- Did school purchase 6 book classics for \$95 that will allow unlimited on-line use?
- Relook at the Mentoring Program. TEAM is supposed to fill the same role as mentoring, but it is hard to measure results.
- Follow up on the motion to spend \$5000 on professional development. Some money was to be moved from buying nonfiction texts to professional development that is research based, effective and gives teaching strategies. We want to have department chairs observe what other school districts in our area are doing to see what successes they have. Brighton High School's math department has had great success sharing Kahn Academy (free online tutorials) with their students.
