Anne Hunter – Welcomed everyone

Anne Hunter – asked if it was possible to use some funds next year for some kind of accelerated Math. Scott told the Council work was already in process to address Math needs. Martha Kuperschmidt is writing a STEM Grant and the money from that grant is to be spent on upgrading technology and online XL math programs. Hopefully, they will be able to buy laptops or tablets and access accelerated math programs online at SLCC.

Crystal Spackman – reviewed her proposal (handout was provided). She is asking to use Trustland money of approximately \$7,000 to purchase new novels for English classes. Motioned was approved – Diane Cosgrove and Anne Hunter.

Jeremy Taeloalii – addressed the Council about *7 Habits of Highly Effective People* and *The Leader in Me* by Stephen Covey. He would like to see the ideas from those books integrated into the Curriculum at Murray High.

Christy Waite is in charge of the PLT class and oversees preparation for TEAM classes. Since these classes are closely related to this issue it was recommended that the idea should be revisited with her and her group of teachers.
